

## **1.1 – Policy Statement of Intent**

### **Demon Drillers Ltd**

1. The Company recognises its health and safety duties imposed by The Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999, the Health and Safety (Consultation with Employees) Regulations 1996 and the Safety Representatives and Safety Committees Regulations 1997.
2. The Company proposes always to comply with its duties under s2 of The Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 to:
  - (a). Provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities.
  - (b). Consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety.
  - (c). Provide and maintain safe plant and equipment.
  - (d). Ensure safe handling and use of substances.
  - (e). Provide information, instruction and supervision for employees.
  - (f). Ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks, and to give them adequate training.
  - (g). Prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health.
  - (h). Maintain safe and healthy working conditions.
  - (i). Review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.
3. Prime responsibility for health and safety lies with the Managing Director of the Company. The Company regards itself as bound by any acts or omissions of the Managing Director, or Senior Manager, giving rise to liability, provided only that such acts/omissions arise out of and in the course of company business, and prosecution of any Director or Senior Manager shall not prevent a further prosecution against the Company.
